



Entry Form - Graduate Metal XIV

Graduate Metal XIV is an award exhibition that will be held in conjunction with the biennial Jewellers and Metalsmiths Group of Australia Conference 2015.

This exhibition will be the fourteenth survey of jewellery and metalsmithing graduates from tertiary institutions in Australia and New Zealand.

The exhibition will be held from 7 -11 July 2015 at The Depot Gallery, 2 Danks Street Waterloo.

Participants in this exhibition can expect their work to be seen by a national and international audience of fellow jewellers and other members of the craft and design community including curators, gallerists, media and collectors.

In addition to exposure to this audience, there will be awards judged by a distinguished international panel, and presented at the exhibition opening.

Selection criteria:

Entry to Graduate Metal is available to graduates from Australia and New Zealand. Students who have completed a, Diploma, Associate Diploma, Advanced Diploma, Undergraduate or Honours degree in jewellery and/or metalsmithing since the last JMGA Biennial Conference in Brisbane in July 2013 are eligible to enter.

The work must have been made in their graduating year as part of their studies.

One entry per person and up to three pieces in a series may be submitted.

Artwork must be complete and original.

Artwork may be for sale.

All entries will be reviewed by a selection committee and entrants will be advised whether they are successful by early March 2015.

Successful entrants will be notified and supplied with the terms and conditions should they intend to exhibit. They will also be required to send specific information about the work they intend to exhibit, images of the work for the catalogue (if different from the images sent for initial entry). Freight and insurance will be the responsibility of the exhibitor.

A \$60 exhibition entry fee is payable by successful entrants.

Please note - students are not required to pay the entry fee for the initial selection process; payment is required if selected and intend to exhibit.



If the quality of the actual work is not consistent with the images provided the entrant may be refused the right to display the work in the exhibition.
